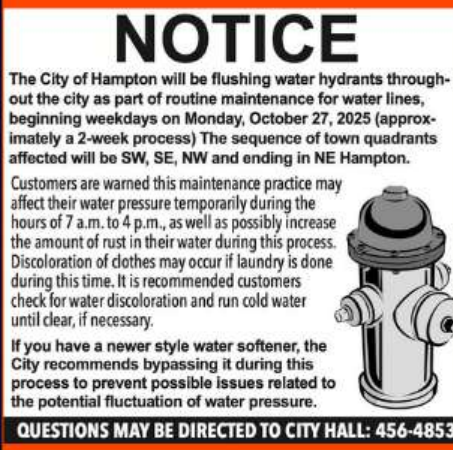

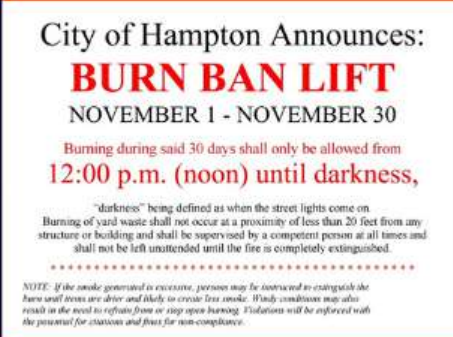

NOTICE
 The City of Hampton will be flushing water hydrants throughout the city as part of routine maintenance for water lines, beginning weekdays on Monday, October 27, 2025 (approximately a 2-week process). The sequence of town quadrants affected will be SW, SE, NW and ending in NE Hampton.
 Customers are warned this maintenance practice may affect their water pressure temporarily during the hours of 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., as well as possibly increase the amount of rust in their water during this process. Discoloration of clothes may occur if laundry is done during this time. It is recommended customers check for water discoloration and run cold water until clear, if necessary.
 If you have a newer style water softener, the City recommends bypassing it during this process to prevent possible issues related to the potential fluctuation of water pressure.

City of Hampton Announces:
BURN BAN LIFT
NOVEMBER 1 - NOVEMBER 30
 Burning during said 30 days shall only be allowed from **12:00 p.m. (noon) until darkness**,
 "darkness" being defined as when the street lights come on.
 Burning of yard waste shall not occur at a proximity of less than 20 feet from any structure or building and shall be supervised by a competent person at all times and shall not be left unattended until the fire is completely extinguished.
 NOTE: If the smoke generated is excessive, persons may be instructed to extinguish the fire until it is under control and then to call the fire department. Windy conditions may also result in the need to refrain from or stop open burning. Violations will be enforced with the punishment for citations and fines for non-compliance.

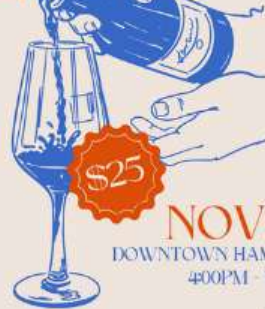
