


triangle and dark red border that must be displayed on rear of vehicle for ag or personal use.

- Out-of-state vehicle must have an lowa DNR nonresident user permit
- Functioning required equipment including but not limited to: born, mirrors, headlight(s), tail lights, and brake lights.


