BURN BAN LIFT

NOVEMBER 1 - NOVEMBER 30

Burning during said 30 days shall only be allowed from
12:00 p.m. (noon) until darkness,

"darkness" being defined as when the street lights come on. Burning of yard waste shall not occur at a proximity of less than 20 feet from any structure or building and shall be supervised by a competent person at all times and shall not be left unattended until the fire is completely extinguished.

NOTE: If the smoke generated is excessive, persons may be instructed to extinguish the burn until items are drier and likely to create less smoke. Windy conditions may also result in the need to refrain from or stop open burning. Violations will be enforced with the potential for citations and fines for non-compliance.
